



THE AMERICAN BOARD OF NEUROPSYCHIATRY

Information Sheet: applicants for certification in neuropsychiatry

Applicants must have completed the following prior to applying:

- 1) A US or Canadian residency in psychiatry or neurology
- 2) A fellowship in neuropsychiatry, behavioral neurology, or neurocognitive physiology or electrophysiology at a US, Canadian, UK, Netherlands, Scandinavian, Israeli or German accredited fellowship program. Applicants who have not completed a fellowship but have completed at least five years of professional clinical work in neuropsychiatry may also apply, however, there will likely be additional requirements that will be prescribed based on each applicant's professional background, education, academic work and experience.

Applicants should show academic work related to neuropsychiatry. This may include, but not be necessarily limited to, research, publications, and presentations. In addition, applicants must submit a personal statement describing their motivation for pursuing a sub-specialty in neuropsychiatry. Applicants must be of good moral character.

Information checklist

Applicants must submit the following items, either by e-mail (ana.dubolev@theacnm.com) or USPS certified with return receipt requested (mailing address is at the bottom of page) by either June 30 or January 31 of each year:

- 1) Certificates or letters indicating the applicant has completed a required residency in Psychiatry or Neurology and either a required accredited fellowship or evidence showing a dedication to the clinical practice of neuropsychiatry for the past five years.
- 2) Publications, papers, research data and presentation material dedicated to the field of psychiatry. Note: plagiarism will result in an automatic lifetime ban from re-application and will be reported to appropriate licensing and regulatory authorities.
- 3) A personal statement of no less than 500 words describing why the applicant has chosen the sub-specialty of neuropsychiatry.
- 4) A non-refundable application fee of \$750.00 (check).

Applicants selected to site for the written examination and oral interview will be notified within 45 days of receipt of their application – e-mail correspondence is preferred. Oral interviews will be held at our New York office unless otherwise indicated.
